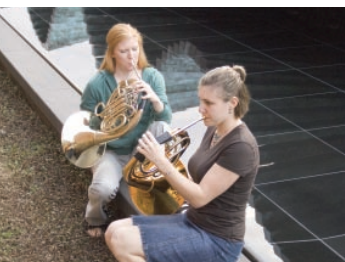

Career and Internship Fairs

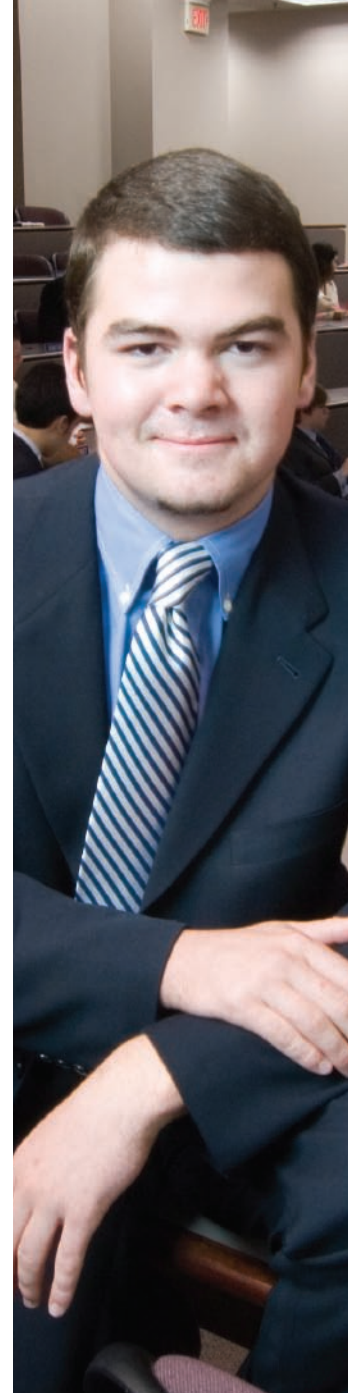

Other Opportunities to Connect with SMU Students

We also provide opportunities for potential employers to meet informally with students to share information about their organizations through participation in programs like Resumania, Mock Interviews, Job Search seminars, Job Shadowing and career programs for specific majors and career fields.

Resumania Employers sign up for a one- to two-hour time slot



to critique students' resumes. This also gives the employers a chance to meet informally with SMU students for future opportunities.

Speed Networking This event is an opportunity for students to learn the art of making meaningful connections and having meaningful conversation with those who can assist in their job search and career development. Through meeting one-on-one with several employers from a variety of industries for 5-7 minutes each, the students further develop their professional communication and networking skills.

Industry Panels Throughout the year, employers from various industries (government, non-profits, performing arts, etc.), serve on panels to discuss their roles and the processes to start a career path in their particular industry.
