The tour explores modern French painting and the significant contributions of Realism,

##### TUESDAY, JUNE 12- PARIS and GIVERNY

Full day tour: Musee Marmottan and Monet's estate at Giverny.

##### WEDNESDAY, JUNE 13 - PARIS

Full day tour: Musee Rodin and Musee d'Orsay.

##### THURSDAY, JUNE 14 - PARIS

Full day visit to the Louvre.

##### FRIDAY, JUNE 15 – PARIS

Full day tour: Musee de l'Orangerie, and Montmartre.

Dinner at historic bistro.

##### SATURDAY, JUNE 16 – PARIS

Day at leisure.

Morning visit to Musee Chagall and Musee Matisse.

##### Ground Transportation:
