Dear Student,

Financial Aid is reviewing your application for federal and institutional aid and has determined that you are not making Satisfactory Academic Progress because:

1. Your cumulative **GPA** at the end of the spring term was **below 2.000**.
OR
2. The number of hours you have **earned** toward your Undergraduate Degree while you have been enrolled at SMU does not equal 80% of the hours you have **enrolled in**.

A student who does not meet both of these requirements for Satisfactory Academic Progress is not in compliance with Federal and Institutional Regulations governing the awarding of financial aid. Therefore, your academic status prohibits SMU from awarding you any additional aid. See SAP Policy and Procedures at:

You may appeal this decision if you complete the enclosed Satisfactory Academic Progress form, have the form signed by your Academic Advisor, and return it along with a personal letter to your Financial Aid Advisor, Suite 119, Blanton Student Services Building.

If this appeal is approved, you will be awarded financial aid for the fall term only. **During this fall probationary period you should take advantage of the resources offered at the Learning Enhancement Center on campus. This center offers tutoring, testing, counseling and study suggestions to help you focus on earning all the hours you enroll in and maintaining the grade point average necessary for graduation. When grades are posted for the fall term, your cumulative GPA must be a 2.000 or better and you must have completed 80% of the hours that you attempted in fall in order to be awarded for spring term.

If your cumulative GPA is not 2.000 or better and/or you have not completed 80% of the hours that you attempted in the fall term, you will be contacted by your Financial Aid Advisor about your options for receiving financial aid in spring.

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Appeal Instructions for Satisfactory Academic Progress

You have applied for need-based financial aid. Federal and Institutional Regulations prohibit SMU from awarding aid to you because of your current academic status.

In order to appeal this process, please take all the following steps:

1. **Write a formal letter** to your Financial Aid Advisor explaining why your cumulative GPA is below a 2.000 AND / OR the hours you have earned since enrolling at SMU does not equal 80% of the hours you have attempted. Your **letter should outline your plan** to sufficiently improve your GPA and number of hours earned in order to meet the requirements for graduation.
2. Ask your Academic Advisor to **evaluate your plan and sign** the statement below.
3. **Return** your letter and this signed statement to your Financial Aid Advisor in the Division of Enrollment Services, Suite 119, in Blanton Student Services Building. *

ACADEMIC ADVISOR'S STATEMENT

I have reviewed the above named student's academic record and plans for improvement. According to Financial Aid Policy the student is not making Satisfactory Academic Progress and this could impact his/her eligibility for Financial Aid next year. I have advised the student that Financial Aid may be in jeopardy unless a 2.000 cumulative GPA and full time enrollment are maintained.
