

### Bed Lofting Height Regulations

Upon move-in beds will be set at “regular” height which is 44” or below from the top of the mattress to the floor.

There are three options to raise your bed if you living in the following halls:

- **McElvaney**
- **Mary Hay**
- **Peyton**
- **Shuttles**

#### Option 1

4th notch from the bottom  
44” from top of mattress to the floor  
Dresser will fit under bed  
Guardrail not needed for this option

#### Option 2

7th notch from the bottom  
53” from top of mattress to the floor  
42” clearance under bed

#### Option 3

11th notch from the bottom  
65” from top of mattress to the floor  
54” clearance under bed  
***\*Highest a bed can be lofted***

There are four options to raise your bed if you living in the following halls/houses:

- **Boaz**
- **Cockrell-McIntosh**
- **Moore**
- **Morrison-McGinnis**
- **Perkins**
- **Smith**
- **Virginia-Snider**
- **Fraternity Houses**
- **Service House**

#### Option 1

12th notch from the top  
  
44” from top of mattress to the floor  
Dresser will fit under bed  
  
Guardrail not needed for this option

#### Option 2

15th notch from the top  
  
53” from top of mattress to the floor  
42” clearance under the bed

#### Option 3

19th notch from the top  
  
65” from top of mattress to the floor  
54” clearance under the bed

#### Bunk: New Information

Both residents must complete the form  
Top Bed-19<sup>th</sup> notch from bottom  
65” from top of mattress to floor  
Bottom bed-4<sup>th</sup> notch from bottom  
20” from top of mattress to floor

***\*Highest a bed can be lofted***
