## **Student Travel Scholarship Guidelines**

1. The maximum amount of a scholarship for a human rights sponsored trip is \$2,000.
2. For a human rights sponsored trip, a student may request:
  - \$2,000 for one trip
  - \$1,000 each for two trips
3. Scholarships are available for the following kinds of travel:
  - \*Human Rights Education Program-sponsored travel (e.g., Dr. Halperin's trips to Poland, Vietnam, Rwanda, etc.)
  - \*Human rights conference travel (e.g., travel to Amnesty International or other human rights-related meetings)
  - \*Human rights training travel
4. Applications are accepted year-round, but must be received no later than 30 days prior to the beginning of any travel.
5. Students undertaking travel for course credit will be given priority.

### **Procedure**

1. Complete the Student Travel Scholarship Application form.
2. Attach a short statement (1 page) describing your specific academic and personal goals related to this travel.
