Student Travel Scholarship Guidelines

1. The maximum amount of a scholarship is \$1,000.
2. A student may receive no more than two travel scholarships total.
3. Scholarships are available for the following kinds of travel:
 - *Human Rights Education Program-sponsored travel (e.g., Dr. Halperin's trips to Poland, Vietnam, Rwanda, etc.)
 - *Other SMU-sponsored human rights travel (e.g., the Spring Break Civil Rights Tour)
 - *Human rights conference travel (e.g., travel to Amnesty International or other human rights-related meetings)
 - *Human rights training travel
4. Applications are accepted year-round, but must be received no later than 30 days prior to the beginning of any travel.
5. Students undertaking travel for course credit will be given priority.

Procedure

1. Complete the Student Travel Scholarship Application form.
2. Attach a short statement (1 page) describing your specific academic and personal goals related to this travel.
