Driving Directions From Taos:

1. Travel southwest on Highway 68 (Paseo del Pueblo Sur) towards Ranchos de Taos.
2. Turn south (left) on Highway 518 at the traffic light (Shell Station is on the left).
3. Continue approximately eight miles south on Highway 518.
4. Look for the Pot Creek Pueblo Visitor's center on the left
5. The main campus is located just past the visitor's center on the west (right) side of the road
6. Excavations are taking place at the large white weather port on the north end of campus (visible from the road).
