Psychology Research Assistant Position

What is it? We conduct research projects aimed at understanding decisions people make about their health-related behaviors (e.g., diet, exercise, smoking).

What would I do? Research assistants do a variety of tasks, including recruitment of research participants, running study sessions, data coding, and data entry.

Can I earn credit? Yes, you can earn 1-3 elective credits each semester you are involved (1 credit = 3 hours/week; 2 credits = 6 hours/week; 3 credits = 9 hours/week). Plus, research experience is very important if you plan to attend graduate school.

What is the commitment? You need to commit to work in the lab for at least one semester, but committing to two semesters (or more) is preferable.
