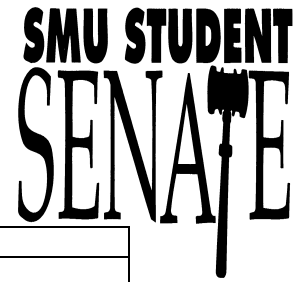

 - *Senator Esau and myself got to go to a meeting with Mark Rhodes about Parking. Before I went in I had gotten a boot so I was already a little upset but we sat down and talked for two hours. We brought suggestions that we had and we showed him the legislation we passed a few months ago. One of our suggestions was e-mailing students their number of tickets so that less students get boots. We had wanted to color code the signs but President Turner would only allow two colors on signs. He really wants to work with us and he is open for revisions to his rules. I think Senate should work on revising these and improving them to be student friendly. He also went over the mustang express and funding for park and pony. He really emphasized the importance of input from students. I invite whoever wants to to work on legislation. We also talked about a parking tutorial online as to where students can and cannot park. Please let me know if you want to work on legislation. Johnson: did you talk about other repercussions other than monetary for parking tickets? We did not address this directly but he did say that the only way students learn the rules of parking is through their wallet. Washington: do you have any idea the percentage of their budget that they get from tickets? It is huge but I don't have a number. Meyer: Does the school get any percentage of the funds from the tickets? I don't know. Park and Pony isn't out to take your money its to regulate student parking. If we came up with a universal sticker, then it would benefit all students.*
