September 26, 2011 (Monday) – Code Change Proposal solicitation begins

September 26 – November 4<sup>th</sup> – Student Body Secretary presents Code Change Proposals upon receipt to Student Senate and answers preliminary questions without debate

November 4, 2011 (Friday) – Code Change proposals due

Week of November 14<sup>th</sup> – Code Revision Committee meets to discuss proposals and make recommendations

November 22, 2011 – Revised Code recommendations are presented and debated in Student Senate general meeting

November 28, 2011 (Monday) – Complaints on current Code recommendations due to Student Body Secretary

Week of November 28<sup>th</sup> – Code Revision Committee meets to discuss complaints

November 29, 2011 (Tuesday) – Revised Code recommendations are presented and debated in Student Senate general meeting

By December 5, 2011 (Monday) – Approved Code changes sent to Vice-President for Student Affairs, Dean of Student Life and Associate Legal Counsel for comments

January 23, 2012 (Monday) – Comments due back to Student Body Secretary from Vice-President, Dean, and Legal Counsel

Week of January 30, 2012 – Code Revision Committee reconvenes to address Vice-President, Dean, and Legal Counsel's comments

February 7, 2012 (Tuesday) – Comments and any subsequent recommendations presented to Student Senate

February 14, 2012 (Tuesday) – Student Senate votes on current comments and recommendations

By February 20, 2012 (Monday) – Approved Code changes are returned to Vice-President, Dean, and Legal Counsel for any additional comments

February 27, 2012 (Monday) – Comments due back to Secretary from Vice-President, Dean, and Legal Counsel

Week of March 5, 2012 – Code Revision Committee reconvenes to address Vice-President, Dean, and Legal Counsel's comments

March 13, 2012 (Tuesday) – Comments and any subsequent recommendations presented to Student Senate

March 13, 2012 (Tuesday) – Student Senate votes on Code to be sent to President

By March 19, 2012 (Monday) – Final Code Change Proposals sent to President

April 10, 2012 (Tuesday) – New Student Code of Conduct presented to Student Senate
