WHEREAS the Academic Enhancement Committee was created in 2001, for an unknown purpose, and

AWARE that the Academic Enhancement Committee may not have been properly created as no resolutions establishing it are present in any Public Information File, nor in the minutes of any meeting from the relevant year, and

NOTING that the only mention of the Academic Enhancement Committee in our governing documents is, "The Academic Enhancement Committee shall strive to promote and enhance the academic level of the University" (By Laws V.1.1), and

COGNIZANT that the Academic Enhancement Committee gave a total of four committee reports between its founding and September of 2005, and that the committee was generally inactive with few members, and

FURTHER AWARE that although Academic Enhancement was a functioning committee last year, its tasks are ambiguous and could be subsumed by the Student Issues Committee, and

EMPHASIZING that each standing committee should be both active and have a roster of dedicated members, and

FURTHER NOTING that because of the deliberate chair vacancy for Academic Enhancement, and its non-inclusion on the Committee Preference Form disseminated at the August 22 meeting, this committee would be doomed to another year of inactivity and lack of membership,

BE IT THEREFORE  
RESOLVED Article V, Section 1, Subsection 1 of the Student Senate By-Laws be stricken, and
