



## **Student Senate Fall 2011 Scholarships and Requirements**

(Every scholarship requires two recommendations from a member of the SMU faculty, staff, or administration. All Scholarships can only be awarded for tuition.)

**All applicants must meet the following requirements:**

- **You must have an SMU GPA to apply.**
- **You must not have been a recipient of a past SMU Student Senate Scholarship.**

### **GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS**

**International Student Scholarship - \$1,000 (awarded to either undergraduate or graduate students)**

*Requirements:* Must be an SMU international student who demonstrates academic excellence as well as a strong connection to the campus community through involvement.

**James J. Saccacio Scholarship - \$1,500 (awarded to either undergraduate or graduate students)**

*Requirements:* Must be an SMU student who has demonstrated financial need and shown leadership and involvement in SMU activities.

**Laura Kittinger- Class of 1984 Scholarship - \$1,000**

*Requirements:* Must be a graduate student who attended SMU at least two years at the undergraduate level and graduated within the past six months. Candidates should have had at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA while at SMU, and they must be well rounded in the areas of student activities and community service.

**Nancy Underwood Graduate Student Leadership and Achievement Scholarship – \$1,000**

*Requirements:* Must be a graduate student who has contributed significantly to the graduate school and the SMU community through leadership, service, and participation in student organizations, and who has shown outstanding academic achievement in his/her chosen field of study.

**Robert Burrell Leadership and Involvement Scholarship - \$1,000 (awarded to either undergraduate or graduate students)**

*Requirements:* Must be an SMU student who has shown leadership and involvement in SMU activities. Candidates should have a minimum cumulative SMU GPA of 3.0.

**Willis M. Tate Academic Scholarship - \$1,000 (awarded to either undergraduate or graduate students)**

*Requirements:* Must be an SMU student who has contributed to the SMU community through leadership and service. Candidates should have a minimum SMU GPA of 3.5.

### **UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS**

**Elizabeth Lee Evans Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000**

*Requirements:* Must be an undergraduate student who has demonstrated financial need. Candidates should have a minimum cumulative SMU GPA of 3.0.

**International Student Scholarship - \$1,000 (awarded to either undergraduate or graduate students)**

*Requirements:* Must be an SMU international student who demonstrates academic excellence as well as a strong connection to the campus community through involvement.

**James J. Saccacio Scholarship - \$1,500 (awarded to either undergraduate or graduate students)**

*Requirements:* Must be an SMU student who has demonstrated financial need and shown leadership and involvement in SMU activities.

**Oaklawn Foundation Scholarship - \$1,000**

*Requirements:* Must be an undergraduate student who is a U.S. citizen and has demonstrated financial need. Candidates should have a minimum cumulative SMU GPA of 2.5.

**Robert Burrell Leadership and Involvement Scholarship - \$1,000 (awarded to either undergraduate or graduate students)**

*Requirements:* Must be an SMU student who has shown leadership and involvement in SMU activities. Candidates should have a minimum cumulative SMU GPA of 3.0.

**University Memorial Scholarship - \$1,500**

*Requirements:* Must be an undergraduate student who has shown leadership and involvement in SMU activities. Candidates should have a minimum cumulative SMU GPA of 3.0.

**Willis M. Tate Academic Scholarship - \$1,000 (awarded to either graduate or undergraduate students)**

*Requirements:* Must be an SMU student who has contributed to the SMU community through leadership and service. Candidates should have a minimum SMU GPA of 3.5.
