The organizers of the Eleventh Annual *Legacies* Dallas History Conference welcome proposals from both professional and lay historians on topics related to the theme:
“Once Upon a Time in Big D: More Forgotten Stories.”



Papers might focus on an individual, group, site, event, or community important in the history of Dallas. The aim of the paper will be to rescue the subject from obscurity and acknowledge its importance in the development of Dallas.

All papers must be based on original research and must not have been presented or published elsewhere. The best papers will be published in a subsequent issue of *Legacies: A History Journal for Dallas and North Central Texas*. Those interested in presenting papers should submit a brief summary of their proposal by JULY 1, 2009, to “Dallas History Conference, 1515 S. Harwood St., Dallas, TX 75215.” Those selected will be notified by August 1, 2009.

The Eleventh Annual *Legacies* History Conference will be held on Saturday, January 30, 2010. The conference is jointly sponsored by twelve organizations: the Dallas County Historical Commission, the Dallas County Pioneer Association, Dallas Heritage Village, the Dallas Historical Society, the DeGolyer Library at SMU, the Old Red Museum of Dallas County History & Culture, the Park Cities Historical and Preservation Society, Preservation Dallas, The Sixth Floor Museum at Dealey Plaza, the Texas/Dallas History & Archives Division of the Dallas Public Library, the Texas State Historical Association, and the William P. Clements Center for Southwest Studies at SMU.
