A limited number of tuition assistance scholarships are available to full-time SMU undergraduate students attending SMU-IN-TAOS during the Summer I and/or August Terms (**FUNDS ARE NOT AVAILABLE FOR MAY TERM**; contact your financial adviser for funding options). Assistance is limited, and is awarded at the discretion of the Clements Award Committee. **Awards to students taking courses in June are given preference.** The award applies only to tuition; students receiving a Clements Tuition Assistance Award are responsible for fees, room/board, and transportation expenses. Those receiving staff/dependent benefits through SMU are not eligible. The application deadline is **WEDNESDAY, MARCH 1**. Program application materials must accompany assistance applications. Awards are determined by the Clements Award Committee in the week following the application due date. Award notifications will be e-mailed by Monday, March 20.
