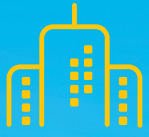

If you're seeking your first undergraduate degree and have at least **50 transferable credit hours**, you are **automatically considered for most of SMU's generous transfer scholarships** when you apply to SMU. These scholarships are renewable for up to five terms as a full-time student with a 3.0 SMU cumulative GPA. Several of our scholarships can be combined. Don't lose out. Apply to SMU today. With a **3.7 minimum transferable GPA** and **50 transferable credit hours**, you are eligible for

**North Texas Community College Scholarship – Deadline April 1**

- Highly competitive scholarship.
- Full-tuition scholarship for fall entry.
- Essay and two to three letters of recommendation required.
- Open to students transferring from Collin, Dallas, Grayson, Trinity Valley, Navarro and Tarrant County community college districts.

**Honor Transfer Scholarship – Reviewed on a rolling basis**

- Automatic consideration with application for half-tuition scholarship for fall, spring or summer entry.

With a **3.5 minimum transferable GPA** and **50 transferable credit hours**, you are eligible for

**Transfer Merit Scholarship – Reviewed on a rolling basis**

- Automatic consideration with application for a \$3,000 scholarship for fall, spring or summer entry.

**Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) – Reviewed on a rolling basis**

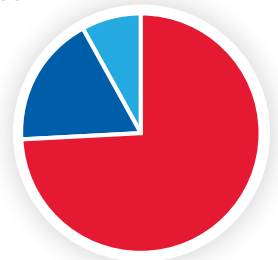
- Competitive, stackable scholarship for fall or spring entry for active PTK members.
- Open to U.S. citizens and permanent residents.
- Additional PTK scholarship application is required.

**Financial aid packages**

We encourage transfer students to complete both their **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** and the **CSS Profile™** to be considered for need-based aid.

## Don't miss your chance at an SMU education.

Get ready for jobs that don't yet exist. Prepare for an evolving world by graduating with multiple competencies and activating new skills.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS



- Completion of a full semester after high school graduation.
- Completion of 24 transferable credit hours\* (2.7 minimum GPA).
- Completion of college-level math course or high school math sequence such as Algebra I and II and geometry within the past three years.

*\*Admission committee will consider the academic rigor of high school courses taken by students with fewer than 24 transferable credit hours.*

### ADMISSION DEADLINES



- **November 1** Spring entry.
- **April 1** Scholarship deadline\*\* for fall entry.
- **June 1** Summer entry.
- **August 1** Fall entry (final deadline).

*\*\*You must have a GPA of 3.5 or above to be considered for scholarships. Apply by April 1 for consideration for the North Texas Community College scholarship. For all other scholarships, applicants are considered on a rolling basis.*

### TRANSFER APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Apply for admission** via SMU's Online Application, the Common Application, ApplyTexas or Apply Coalition with SCOIR.
- Submit the **\$60** nonrefundable application fee.  
**Waived for military veterans and Phi Theta Kappa members.**
- Submit official **transcripts from all colleges and universities** attended (include dual/concurrent coursework completed in high school).  
All international transcripts will require a professional evaluation.
- Submit final **high school transcripts or GED.**
- Submit optional **personal essay, extracurricular resume** and **letters of recommendation.**
- Submit **FAFSA and CSS Profile™** if interested in receiving need-based aid.
