

Bootcamp and Windows 10 Setup

January 2018

Before you begin, verify the machine meets requirements

- An Intel-based Mac
- Windows 10 License key (<http://smu.onthehub.com>)
- At least 60 GB of free disk space on your startup drive

Installing Boot Camp

1. Restart machine and ensure all applications are closed
2. Plug in Windows 10 USB
3. Launch **Finder**
4. Click **Applications**
5. Click **Utilities**
6. Click **Boot Camp Assistant**
7. Click **Continue**
8. If prompted, Uncheck Create a Windows 7 or later version install disk and Download the latest Windows support software from Apple
9. Check **Install Windows 7 or later version**
10. Do not click **Divide Equally, allocate 60 GB of space to the Bootcamp partition**
11. Click **Install**
12. Enter Administrative credentials if prompted
13. After the installation completes, the machine will automatically restart and boot into Windows 10 setup

Windows 10 Setup

Please note: Windows 10 setup steps may vary, proceed through the setup with defaults if you are unsure of the options to select.

1. After boot camp assistant finishes the machine will restart in Windows 10 to continue setup
2. Click **Next**
3. Click **Install Now**
4. A prompt may appear to enter Windows 10 License key, enter the Windows 10 license key
5. Click **Next**
6. Select the operating system **Windows 10 Education**
7. Click **Next**
8. Agree to the license agreement, Click ticker box to agree
9. Click **Next**
10. If prompted, select **Custom: Install Windows Only (Advanced)**
11. **CAUTION**
Select the latest partition created, should be about 60 GB. Do not alter any other



partitions or select a partition that could be the primary Mac operating system. Anything over 60 GB should not be modified in any way.

12. Click **Next**
13. Installation of Windows 10 will resume
14. To begin setup, Click **United States** for Region settings
15. Click **Yes**
16. Select **US** for the Keyboard layout
17. Click **Yes**
18. Click **Skip** for a second keyboard layout
19. If prompted for a network connection, Click **Skip**
20. Enter a computer name
21. Click **Next**
22. If desired, create a password
23. Click **Next**
24. Click **Accept** to apply default for Privacy Settings
25. Windows will launch Boot Camp installer, Click **Next**
26. Accept license agreements, Click **Install**
27. Installation will progress
28. When the installation is completed, click **Finish**
29. Click **Yes** to Restart
30. The machine will reboot
31. Congratulations! Your Installation is now complete
