Stay Alert Around Campus

Whether walking, driving, biking, or riding a scooter, pay extra attention around streets and campus crosswalks. Follow all traffic laws, observe speed limits, and watch for pedestrians. Always use designated crosswalks and check for traffic before you step into the street, especially around areas on campus where construction could obstruct your or a driver's view.

"Avoid, Deny, Defend" in an active threat

- **Avoid:** Pay attention, have an exit plan, and move away quickly from danger.

- **Deny:** Keep your distance, create barriers, and stay hidden and quiet. Mute your phone.
- **Defend:** If necessary, fight back aggressively and decisively.
