Pathway A: Begin Master of Education Summer 2018

- **Requirement:** Undergraduate Cumulative GPA 3.0 and acceptance by admissions committee.
- Action:
 - Complete an application by May 1, 2018 https://gradadmission.smu.edu/apply
 - application, essay, choose one (include STEM Academy participation)
 - Tell us how earning a master's degree will help better your career as an educator.
 - *Tell us your best story.*
 - 2 letters of recommendation
 - resume
 - official undergraduate transcript- (NO GRE Required)
- Note: Applicants whose GPA falls below 3.0 may request an exemption to this requirement by attaching a letter explaining why an exception should be made (such as long-term experience, expertise in a related specialized field, or the Graduate Record Examination score). It is recommended to utilize pathway B, if cumulative GPA requirement is not met.





Pathway B: Begin a Master of Education Spring 2019

• **Requirement:** Cumulative GPA of 3.0 in 12 hours of graduate courses completed in the STEM program at SMU (Summer 2017-Summer 2018) and acceptance by admissions committee

• Action:

- Complete an application by Nov 1, 2018 https://gradadmission.smu.edu/apply
- application, essay, choose one (include STEM Academy participation)
 - Tell us how earning a master's degree will help better your career as an educator.
 - Tell us your best story.
- 2 letters of recommendation
- resume
- official undergraduate transcript- (NO GRE Required)
- recommendation, resume, and official undergraduate transcript NO GRE Required)

Final Deadlines for Admission Consideration

- Apply by May 1, for summer term admission (summer start only guaranteed if all admissions material has been submitted by the May 1 deadline)
- Apply by Nov 1, for Spring term admission.

Application Fee will be waived for STEM Academy students who apply for the Master of Education

Requirements for Students who Obtained their Degree Abroad

- An official translated transcript that has been evaluated by an accredited SMU agency.
 See <u>gradappmaterials@smu.edu</u> for addresses of agencies that translate and evaluate transcripts.
- Students pursing a Master's Degree must have a minimum IELTS score of 6.5 or TOEFL (IBT) score of 92.

Sample Degree Plan Towards Master of Education

- Academy I = 6 hours- STEM Academy coursework
- Academy 2 = 6 hours –STEM Academy coursework
- Academy 3 = 6 hours (STEM EDU 6349 course and EPL Leadership course)
- Academic Coaching = 3 hours
- 3 STEM courses (EDU 6383, EDU 6350, EDU 6351) = 9 hours
- 2 Core Classes = 6 hours (EDU 6304 & EDU 6322)

After Academy 3, students may have two more semester remaining to complete a Master of Education.

How much will it cost to complete the additional courses towards Master of Education?

• SMU will offer discounted tuition to finish out a Master's Degree of \$419/ credit hour. This deep discount is available as a limited-time offer through the fall of 2024.
