RUBOTTOM FOREIGN SERVICE INTERNSHIP FUND

About:

The Rubottom Foreign Service Internship Fund was established by Ambassador R. Richard and Billy Ruth Rubottom to support **public policy or international affairs internships** for undergraduate students who have prepared for a **foreign service career**. The objective of this internship funding is to strongly encourage students **to consider careers in the U.S. Foreign Service and in international affairs**.

The internship funding is designated to highly qualified undergraduates majoring in **Political Science**, **History**, **International Studies**, **Economics or World Languages** at Southern Methodist University, and who intend to pursue an internship with a genuine focus on public policy and/or international relations. (It may NOT be used toward a corporate or industrial-based internship).

<u>Funding</u>: The recipient will be awarded a stipend for \$5,000.

Requirements:

- 1. **Application Form** to include:
 - a. Minimum of 3 years of foreign language study.
 - b. **Unofficial Transcript** with a minimum GPA of 3.3.
 - c. Resume
 - d. **500-700 word statement** of the applicant's objectives and motivations in seeking the internship funding.
 - e. **Two letters of recommendation**. One letter must be from an SMU faculty member or supervisor.

Deliverables:

• The recipient of the internship funding will produce a final paper about what they did, what they learned, and how it will impact their career.

Selection process:

The selection process for the internship funding awarded by the **SMU Tower Center** will be based on the completed delivery of the requirements and merit. Selection will be determined by an application review committee made up of SMU Tower Center Faculty Board members.
