Eastman's plant is the site of our Deep-Direct Use research project looking at ways to use geothermal fluids to make chilled water at night for inlet cooling in the afternoons.

On February 9, 2018 Congress approved a Continuing Resolution which extended **federal tax credits** for residential and commercial installations of **Geothermal Heat Pumps**.
