Did you know? High temperature pressure and sensors can be coated with mullite for use in **high temperature (1,100°C) corrosive environments**. Now commercially available high temperature rated sucker rods have a plasma coat over the electronics tool and the sensors coated with mullite to monitor molten rock and magma. Fast response temperature sensors respond to lava, molten rock, and magma currents, even quantify these currents with a triangular arrangement of these sensors.
