

Health and Society – Historical Admission Data

Admission data for the Health and Society Major are provided below. The percentage of applicants accepted each cycle varies so the information below should be used for reference purpose only. Among the factors that can impact the percentages of applicants admitted each semester includes the quality and size of the applicant pool and the number of spots that are open in the major.

There is a cap on the number of students that can be enrolled in the Health and Society major at any one time. There are generally more spots available to be filled in the fall application cycle, however students with strong and compelling application generally do well in the admissions process regardless of when they apply.
