

Trevor Rees-Jones Library of the American West

- The Rees-Jones Western Americana Collection
 - Initiated in 2011
 - Covers Trans-Mississippi West lands "across the Mississippi"
 - Special emphasis on the Southwest, Texas, northern areas east of the Rocky Mountains (Colorado, Montana, Wyoming)
 - Diversity and depth rare first editions, color plate folios, photographs, maps, and ephemera
 - Pre-1900 focus
- Rees-Jones + DeGolyer Western collections combined will rank alongside the holdings of institutions such as the Bancroft Library (Cal-Berkeley) and the Beineke Library (Yale).



Fondren Library North Prepping the Site

- Collections
 - In 23 weeks, we stored:
 - 150,000 Books, 114 Map Cabinets
 - ~40,000 Boxes of books, government documents, SMU Archives, microforms, Theses & Dissertations, periodicals, cartographic material
 - Available via Iron Mountain by request












Fondren Library North Moving People and Services

- People and Services
 - Renovated spaces and relocated 45 people to Fondren East and West buildings
 - Walls built between old building and main desk in Fondren Link
 - Interlibrary Loan moved
 - All services up and running









Fondren Library North: Student Impact

- Student Impact
 - Change in seating and space configurations
 - Seats -295
 - Study rooms -12
 - Carrels -17



In Process: Student Seating Project

- Now
 - Converted Hillcrest Exhibition Space (near Centennial Reading Room) to student study space
 - +50 seats (existing furniture)
- Spring 2025
 - 19 additional seats: 4th Floor study carrels
 - 56 additional seats: 2nd floor reading room with new furniture
 - 129 additional seats: 1st floor Learning Commons
- Total of 204 seats added back for temporary net loss of 90 seats.







Duda Family Business Library now open!

- Duda Family Business Library
 - Ground floor of the new David B. Miller Business Quadrangle at the Cox School of Business
 - Adjacent to the Kitt Investment and Trading Center
 - Ida Family Reading Room
 - 22 Bookable Cox Team Rooms
- Hamon Library
 - Completed ADA restroom compliance renovations
 - Planning for use of ground floor space that housed the Business Library for 2.5 years
