

Film & Media Arts Internship FINAL REPORT

Write a TYPED, 5-7 page (double-spaced, size 11 or 12 font) report on your internships.

This may include some or all of:

- what they had you do
- what they didn't let you do that you wish they had
- what you liked about the experience
- what you didn't like about the experience
- what you learned
- how what you learned in this internship will help you in your chosen career
- and so on...

You should also note how your coursework/training in the department did (and/or did not) prepare you for this internship. Most importantly, it should show that you've reflected on this experience and used it to advance yourself - technically, or aesthetically, or in your understanding of the industry, etc. - in this field.

This is NOT a research paper but rather a personal reflection. You can use "I" and "me", no need to write in the third-person. That said, the paper should still be well-written and organized, not just stream-of-consciousness, and should of course be devoid of spelling and grammar errors.

You must turn in BOTH (a) one hard copy of the paper and (b) one PDF copy (sent via email). Both versions must be turned in to the internship supervisor at the conclusion of your internship, by the fifth day of finals week for the semester in which you are registered for internship course credit.
