COURSE GOALS

This course examines God's Word as expressed through Israel's prophets, selected Psalms, and selected passages from Wisdom Literature.

Students will be able to:

- Understand origin, history, and use of these forms of biblical literature among God's people.
- Exegete these forms of biblical literature.
- Articulate the nature of stewardship biblically and theologically.
- Apply exeges s to preaching, other pastoral responsibilities, and issues of the present day.

PRE-CLASS ASSIGMENTS

There are three essays included in the pre-class assignments i.e., three essays based on required books. The three essays need to be 12-point font, and double spaced. Must cite the sources and references in each essay. Each essay has its own pages expected for the assignments.

1st Essay- 4-5 Pages: Spirituality of the Psalms. Walter Brueggemann speaks of Psalms of Orientation, Psalms of Disorientation, and Psalms of New Orientation. What is your understanding of Psalms of Orientation. How is Psalm 33, a Psalm of Orientation? How does Psalm 33 relate to the beginning of the book of Proverbs, Chapters 1-9 (refer to The Wisdom Literature, Richard J. Clifford). What is your understanding of Psalms of Disorientation. How is Psalm 74, a Psalm of Disorientation, and in comparison, how does Jeremiah 7 explain the attitude of the Israelites toward God in light of catastrophe, (You Are My People, Stulman and Kim)? Explain your understanding of Brueggemann's explanation of Psalms of New Orientation.

2nd Essay--4 Pages: As you refer to <u>The Wisdom Literature</u>, Richard J. Clifford, consider the role wisdom in the ancient Near East, what do you consider the value of Old Testament Wisdom for today's Christians. What is the value of the Old Testament Prophets for Christians especially in the United States. See You Are My People, Louis Stulman and Hyun Chul Paul Kim.

EXPLANATION OF GRADING SYSTEM

All pre-class assignments will be evaluated:

- Personal creativity and thinking.
- First Essay due on <u>October 3, 2024</u>. The second essay is due on <u>October 14, 2024</u>. Essays turned in after the deadline dates will be marked down two points for each day late
