For those receiving this memo who served during the 2023 – 2024 academic year, thank you for your contributions as members of the search committee for the next Leighton K. Farrell endowed dean of the Perkins School of Theology. Acting on that group's recommendations and as announced last month, we will extend the search through summer and fall 2024 with modest changes to the search committee's composition and with a new executive search partner. We are grateful to Peter Moore for remaining chair of the search committee and to Hugo Magallanes for serving as dean *ad interim* (effective June 1, 2024) until a permanent dean is in place.

After interviewing multiple executive search firms, all with strong experience placing academic leaders in religiously-affiliated schools, we have selected Storbeck Search as our new partners. Their leadership team has most recently supported the dean search at TCU's Brite Divinity School and impressed me during deliberations with their

professionalism, deep understanding of the current leadership landscape, and commitment to expanding and curating the current applicant pool.

Please contact Shanon Rust by Friday, June 7, to let me know if you agree to serve on this committee. We will schedule one committee meeting this summer, joined by our new partners from Storbeck Search, to make the preparations needed for a re-energized search process in line with the start of the fall 2024 semester. I will join at the beginning of this meeting for a time of discussion and Q&A. After consulting everyone's schedules, a calendar invite with meeting logistics will follow.
