

If you haven't already submitted your semester request, NOW is the time before tests are scheduled.

This is very important: Review your request by scrolling through every approved accommodation listed and only have checked the classes you are going to be enrolled in for the fall. 2 reasons:

- 1) You only want a letter sent to the professors that will have you in their class.
- 2) It will expediate the approval of your letter being sent to you and your professors.
- *** It is still the student's responsibility to reach out to their instructor and discuss their accommodation needs after sharing the letter in DASS Link.
