## INDEPENDENT STUDY CONTRACT/PROPOSAL

MLS students may earn up to 6 credit hours through Independent Study in a subject area relevant to the MLS Curriculum. Students must first complete the two required courses and be in good academic standing to be eligible to undertake an independent study. To enroll in an Independent Study, students must work with an MLS faculty member to define specific course requirements and complete an Independent Study Contract subject to the approval of the Director and/or Dean. Independent Study courses may be taken for one, two or three credit hours. The deadline to submit proposals to the MLS office is at least two weeks before the beginning of the term for which the study is requested.

**NOTE:** The expectations to enroll in an independent study through the Master of Liberal Studies program are significant. For each credit hour earned, a student is expected to contribute 8-10 pages of writing. So, for a typical 3 credit independent study, a student is expected to contribute 24 - 30 pages of writing. Make sure that the page length of your writing contribution is clearly indicated below along with the content of the paper.

**NOTE 2:** In order for the expectations and evaluation methods to be clear to the student, the directing faculty member should provide a clear grading rubric and written assignment guidelines. Samples are available in the MLS office for review upon request.
