If your professor wants you to test at DASS for finals, **LISTEN UP!** You need to schedule the final using our Online Scheduler as soon as possible. The deadline to schedule is **11/28/17**, but spots fill up before then, so don't wait. Some sections are already full! If you need to take the final at a different time than the class (only for valid reasons), you **MUST** get written permission from your professor and forward the email to **DASS**. We cross-check them all and could cancel your reservation if you haven't gotten permission. Please don't wait to tie up these details until the week of finals, that causes lots of stress for you and others.
