Coming this summer...introducing DASS Link!



We are excited to announce that we will be rolling out a new electronic system for DASS students.

The entire disability file will become electronic and DASS letters of accommodation will be created within the DASS Link system and students will request their letters by logging into the student portal. Students will request the electronic letters be pushed out to their instructors for each semester (no more picking up letters at our office!).

Students will still be expected to communicate directly with each instructor about implementing the accommodations listed within the letter, but this process should streamline your steps significantly!

Students can make supplemental accommodation requests through the DASS Link system, upload medical documentation, and keep track of all past letters of accommodation. Please be prepared to review the training materials DASS will share over the next few months so you're ready to go in August with the new system.
