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FINAL POINTS ON FINALS AT DASS:

- DASS does not administer exams that need to be taken on a computer unless DASS authorized computer use as an accommodation and it was scheduled ahead of time.
- If you scheduled yourself to test at DASS, be at the LEC at the time you scheduled yourself to test! When you schedule yourself to test at DASS, we hire proctors and your space has been reserved for you. As a result, some students are turned away when the room is full. If your plans change and you won't be needing to test at DASS, you must call at least 24 hours ahead to cancel.
