- ◆ **DASS does NOT proctor tests administered on the computer**, unless it is part  
of your DASS accommodation. In that case, we provide the laptop with no  
internet connection. Please arrange for all other tests (administered on a  
computer) with your instructor.
- ◆ Students must schedule their own tests, within the Online Scheduler, at least  
**7** days in advance.
- ◆ Students must cancel **24 hours** ahead of time-it is a waste of University  
resources to have a proctor waiting for students who do not show.
- ◆ You can start scheduling **finals** at DASS on Tues, Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>. **Our spots for finals  
will fill quickly so get your spot reserved**, if your professor has directed you to  
do so. No finals will be scheduled at DASS after **Nov. 27<sup>th</sup>**.
